#### **II.** Presentations

- a. Advanced Manufacturing Communities Partnership for Sothern California (AMP SoCal) Presentation by Dion Jackson from the University of Southern California Center for Economic Development
  - E.C. WARREN introduced Dion JACKSON Professor at University of Southern California Center for Economic Development.

Dion JACKSON proceeded to her presentation on Advanced Manufacturing Partnership for Southern California. When the presentation was concluded the committee discussed the possible benefits of the partnership.

Efrain SILVA commented about the state of the art facility at Imperial Valley College.

- E.C. WARREN commented we are currently waiting for IVEDC and Imperial County Workforce Development to submit their report on Aerospace and Biofuels cluster; they will identify areas in Imperial County that can be used as manufacturing zones.
- E.C. WARREN commented OECD needs to take a vote to meet next week for the cluster.

E.C WAREN commented the County will be the lead agency; the County needs to submit letters of recommendation. Cities can also submit letters in support of the partnership. T. KELLEY commented we should show that we have industrial sites in the County. Dion JACKSON commented if the County submits a letter, at this point the cities are covered.

- b. U.S. Gypsum Project Update Presentation by IVEDC
  - T. KELLEY commented U.S. Gypsum has finalized their decision to restart line one of their facility. This will retain 20 jobs and create 50 new jobs in manufacturing. The investment made by the company will be from 30-40 million dollars. Sean WILCOCK commented the jobs that will be created will be \$26 per hour jobs, which are high wage jobs.
